# The necessity to organize at the workplace and the unity of the workers, teachers, nurses and retirees on streets!

Recently, In parallel with the uninterrupted and regular protests of the retirees of social security, civil, and army who have turned the streets into protest gathering and expressing their independent demands, another wave of protests in different sections of working class including oil, petrochemical, mining, and steel, also hospitals begun by chanting slogans, demanding their rights making their voices be heard in society.

## Against warmongering policies and for a lasting peace

As one of the imprisoned labor activists and a father in Evin prison, one of the symbols of repression and suffocation in the last 50 years in Iran, I am deeply and increasingly concerned and shocked about the massacre of defenceless people in Gaza, especially thousands of children.

Despite the relentless suppression of the Iranian labor movement by the Islamic Republic for more than four decades, and despite the firing, imprisonment, and harassment of us and our families by this government, our movement has always been and will always be one of the defenders of workers and toilers and oppressed people in the world. International solidarity with the toilers and deprived people of the world is not just a choice for us, but a fundamental human duty. It is not without reason that labor organizations and activists in most countries of the world, while condemning the killing of civilians by the Israeli government and Hamas, they have increasingly condemned the killing of more than 13,000 civilians in the Gaza Strip in the past six weeks by the Israeli army, including more than 8,000 children and Women as genocide and a gross flagrant violation of all international laws and hundreds of resolutions against war and for an immediate ceasefire in recent days.

The Workers' Syndicate of Tehran and Suburbs Bus Company (Sherkat -e- Wahed) is supporting these resolutions and specifically the call of the majority of labor and philanthropic organizations in the world for an immediate stoppage of the killing of civilians, and an immediate ceasefire, ending of the war, the withdrawal of military forces and those affiliated with the Israeli government from all occupied Palestinian territories and the recognition of the right to self-determination for the Palestinian people. I hope we will see the expansion and spread of these calls for an immediate ceasefire.

There is no doubt that using this method of protest will strengthen the struggles of official oil workers.

The importance of this statement is that it puts the defense of peace, resistance against violence against children and violation of human rights, occupation, aggression and repression in its proper and necessary place.


The regime that slaughters and suppresses dissidents and protestors
